# BOXSCORES OF 34 GAMES IN 1ST HALF OF THE 2001 REGULAR SEASON <br> By an Ancient Scottish Reporter 

STANFORD - With the 2001 regular nearing its end, The Sentinel apologizes for its late start in resuming publication. For our new readers, we wish to explain that with just one reporter and two simultaneous games on 61 of the 69 regular season evenings, we cover only $53 \%$ of the action.
